# Acknowledgment

In the morning of snowy day, I am looking back my old days, I have lived a long life but the loneliness of the gut would remain there till I finish my life. For 30 years' work, I have been interested in others' works, envied them and was not satisfied with my own works. However, my works containing the enthusiasm to express something showed traces of my feelings.

Although it is natural to express Korean motives, as I am a Korean, my works always had similar images and subjects while I moved to another materials and another methods from dyeing works I started first. As other peoples, there are many patterns that represent Korean images. All of them such as wells and roof blocks in traditional houses, pottery, rice cake patterns in everyday life, ten good things inherited with wishes of people in old days (Sibjangseang-Sun, Cloud, Mountain, Water, Pine Tree, Bamboo, Agedefying weeds, Deer, Crane and Tortoise), and lotus, flowers, fish, peaches and butterflies that were frequently shown in folk paintings were the materials I use frequently. They have the most appropriate meanings and values representing the emotion and style of Korea.

I made dyeing color from yellow soil, the natural material, painted it on Korean paper, added colors to make colorful Korean paper, the main material of my works, drew basic shapes, tore and pasted them to represent breath of our ancestors and create the image of Korea newly. I hope that the consciousness through my eyes will represent the breath of my ancestors and revive it in the work I made. I will do my best till I finish my life and it will be reborn everyday with different shapes.
